Hostile Environment Awareness Training (HEAT)

1.1 Overview

This Highfield International Accredited qualification is developed and owned by Salama Fikira Group Ltd (Centre). Upon conclusion of the training course, clients will be fully capable of ensuring the long-term safety and security of their personnel while deployed in challenging environments. Instructors work directly with the client's management to develop a bespoke training package delivered in accordance with Highfields International standards

1.2 How long will it take me to achieve this qualification?

This programme is delivered over 3 or 5 days; however, the time may be adjusted in accordance with learners' needs and/or local circumstances.

1.3 How is the qualification assessed?

The qualification is assessed in **three** parts:

- **Part 1:** assessed through a knowledge based written/online exam and learners will have to achieve a minimum of 80% to pass this knowledge exam. The centre assessor will mark learner responses.
- **Part 2:** assessed through simulated activities, for learners to be assessed on their participation, and quick decision-making abilities.
- **Part 3:** To achieve the Highfield Level 3 International Award in First Aid at Work and Use of an AED, the learners will be assessed on the knowledge and the practical assessments as per the requirement stated in the Highfield Course Specification, found on this link:

1.4 How is this course delivered?

The first aspect is to provide participants with a good theoretical basis from which to approach security threat issues, and allow participants to apply this knowledge through practical exercises and group work. The second aspect requires learners to understand how to administer effective first aid to a casualty in order to save a life prior to arrival of qualified medical assistance.

To effectively deliver this qualification appropriate resources and safety measures must be put in place:

- classrooms with suitable seating and desks, laptop, flip chart, projector to conduct the knowledge-based learning outcomes. Each module contains PowerPoint presentations to introduce each theme, as well as detailed explanation by the trainers to assist learners in acquiring further insight on the subject
- Practical exercises through mock scenarios (where possible) will be demonstrated through realistic simulation to enable learners adapt quick decisiveness in choosing appropriate responses in future situations they may encounter.
- A number of group-work assignments designed to allow participants apply the concepts presented will be applied throughout delivery to ensure learning has taken place and safe operating procedures throughout the conduct of the training and assessment sessions will be strictly observed, also any permissions required by the local authority on conduct of training sessions on/off site will be obtained prior to the training.

1.5 Where can this course be taken?

This qualification is currently available for learners outside the United Kingdom and can be obtained at SF Group's Highfield approved training centres within Africa and Asia regions.
